Policies:

Late Work: Work not completed on time is automatically 50% off. However, students may turn in late work for ½ credit. Late work must be turned in before the end of each chapter.

Absent Work: When a student is absent, it is his or her responsibility to ask for assignments. Please check the homework request bin and speak with Mr. Breden. If a student knows in advanced that he or she is going to absent, please notify Mr. Breden.

Tardy and Student I.D.:

In accordance with the school handbook, students are considered tardy if they are not in their seats when the bell rings. Students will receive consequences as follows:

- **An after school detention on their third tardy.**
- **An administrative referral for the fourth tardy, which will result in two after school detentions.**
- **An administrative referral for the 5th tardy, which will result in a 1-day in-school suspension.**

The same guidelines will be followed for a student not wearing their I.D.

Consequences will start over at the beginning of each new quarter.

Academic Dishonesty:

- Cheating is a serious offense and will have serious consequences.
- If a student is found copying from a classmate's paper, then both will be confiscated and given to the teacher who assigned the work.
- Both students involved in being dishonest on work I have assigned will receive a zero on the assignment and a referral to administration.
- Academic dishonesty on quizzes and tests will be recorded as a zero for both students involved and both will receive an administrative referral.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- **Chewing Gum and Candy:** For health and safety reasons, chewing gum and candy are not permitted during school hours or on the bus. When these items are permitted by authorized school personnel, we ask that disposal be made in appropriate containers.
- **Cell Phones/Electronic Devices:** While it is permissible for you to have a cell phone or electronic device at school for use during after- school hours, it must be turned off and put away during the school day. Students whose cell phones/electronic devices cause a disruption will be disciplined. There are phones in the main office available for student use before and after school.
